How to get to UCD Conway Institute

Belfield Campus

UCD Conway Institute is located at Belfield, the main University College Dublin campus which is located 4km south of Dublin city centre.



To access UCD Conway Institute, enter via the N11 entrance (orange star). The Conway Institute is building 18 (yellow arrow) and is a 5 minute walk from the main entrance (follow orange path). Taxis can drop off in the car park to the right of the entrance.



Plane

We recommend you take the <u>Aircoach</u> which operates a service from Dublin Airport. The 700 bus, direction **Leopardstown/Sandyford** runs every 15 minutes from Dublin Airport and the journey takes 45-50 minutes (once it is not rush hour).

There is a stop at UCD. A return trip costs €14.

Public Transport

<u>Hit the Road</u> shows you how to get to or from UCD Belfield Campus using a combination of Dublin Bus, Luas and DART links. You can also change searching options and search how to get from point A to B anywhere in Dublin.

Train

Dublin is served by two main railway stations: Connolly Station and Heuston Stations. It is a short walk from Connolly Station to O'Connell Street, where the Dublin Bus numbers 46A and 39A can be boarded for UCD. The route 145 provides a direct route from Heuston Station to Belfield via the city centre.

Bus - Dublin Bus

Dublin Bus provide services to the Belfield campus. Click <u>here</u> for a guide to buses serving the campus or see Dublin Bus' own <u>Student Smarts interactive map</u>.

Please note that Dublin buses only accept euro coins, not notes.

Bus - Bus Eireann

Bus Éireann provides a nationwide bus service, with most major areas having a regular link to Dublin. The majority of Dublin services terminate in Busáras (Central Bus Station, Dublin) from where it is a short walk to O'Connell Street for connecting buses to UCD.

Taxi

There are usually an adequate number of taxis in operation in the city centre at any given time. It is possible to hail a taxi from the street, but convenient taxi ranks are located on O'Connell Street, Middle Abbey Street, Dame Street and St Stephens Green.

Car

We would not advise driving. Please note that parking on campus is extremely limited. Visitor cars must be parked in designated pay and display areas.

How to get to Talbot Hotel Stillorgan

The **Talbot Hotel Stillorgan** is located 2 km south of UCD's Belfield campus, on the N11.

If coming directly from **Dublin Airport**, we recommend using the route 700 <u>Aircoach</u>, direction Leopardstown/Sandyford, which leaves every 15 minutes and costs €14 return. The name of the stop on the timetable is "Stillorgan Park Hotel" (old hotel name).

The hotel is also accessible by bus, or by taking a taxi.

How to get to UCD Conway Institute from the Talbot Hotel Stillorgan

The hotel has a **shuttle bus**, which can drop guests to UCD. The hotel is aware that there is a group of guests attending a workshop in UCD on 12-13 October.

A number of **buses** run directly from Stillorgan to the front gate of campus. The bus stop (direction city centre, Stop 461) is on the opposite side of the dual carriage way to the hotel. The 46A and 145 buses serve UCD flyover (Stop 768). Buses will only accept coins, not notes. There is a dedicated bus lane all the way.

Walking: it is 2 km to UCD, straight along the N11 dual carriage way. You will need to cross over the dual carriage way. When you arrive at the main entrance, follow the directions on the campus map above.

The Receptionist can order you a taxi. It is a short inexpensive journey.

How to get from UCD Conway Institute to the dinner

It is a short walk (1.4 km) from UCD Conway Institute to the Merrion Inn (188 Merrion Road).

From the UCD Conway Institute: exit the building and turn right, go right under the arch between 2 buildings. Walk straight ahead and veer right down the short road to the right hand side of the UCD Bowl (football pitch). There is a pedestrian exit here. Turn right and walk down the road Greenfield Park/Nutley Lane for 1.2 km, crossing the main dual carriage way as you walk. At the bottom of Nutley Lane, turn right and cross over the Merrion road (St. Vincent's Hospital is on this corner). The Merrion Inn is here. Map below and staff will be on hand to assist with directions.

Alternatively, taxis can be hailed from the main entrance.
