- To incorporate the most recent advances in grassland management for dairy farms into a high- output system
- Use a type of dairy cow that has good genetic indices for both milk production and fertility
- Employ the best practices from nutrition research and dairy cow husbandry
- Incorporate nutritional studies into a high-output system
- To incorporate management technologies and system attributes that enhance the sustainability of dairy production

#### **Grazing plan:**

The AFC was recorded at 775kg on the 28<sup>th</sup> of April, with growth rates of 99kg of DM/ha. To manage the grass supply and quality effectively, grass walks are being conducted weekly. 2.11ha was cut for silage on the 28<sup>th</sup> of April and yielded 23 bales.

Two paddocks (2.12 ha) were successfully sown with a Germinal Seeds reseed mix, including Aberclyde, Barwave, Aberwolf, Abergreen, and white clover. The clover component included Aberherald and Aberswan at a rate of 1.5 kg/acre (4 kg/ha), ensuring a balanced, high-quality sward aimed at improved productivity and persistence.

The diet consists of a grass allocation of 15.5kg DM and 8kg of concentrates.

Weather and ground conditions are being closely monitored. Soil temperature measurements were taken on the 28<sup>th</sup> of April, with the average recorded at 12.86°C. Between the 24th of April and 1st of May 5mm of rain fell on the platform.

# Comment:

55 cows were BCS on the 2nd of May. 9% scored  $\leq$  2.5, 20% scored 2.75, 38% scored 3.0, 27% scored 3.25 and 2% scored 3.5.
