The Global Engagement Master's Partnership Pathway (GEMPP) Programmes offer students the best way to prepare for their world class UCD master's degree through a combination of academic, language, cultural, and study skills modules.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

The GEMPP Programmes offer a one semester programme starting in January (3.5+0.5+1) or a two semester programme beginning in September (3+1+1). Students take English for Academic Purposes and subject-specific modules, plus options in thesis preparation, cultural studies, and creative thinking, preparing them for their UCD master's programmes.

GEMPP students at UCD enjoy full access to a comprehensive suite of student support services and amenities, designed to enrich their university experience. These resources include the Career Network, which provides guidance on career planning and opportunities, the extensive University Library, and the vibrant Student Centre, home to a swimming pool, cinema, sports halls, and a variety of other amenities.

GEMPP students must meet the academic entry requirements of their chosen master's programme. Students meeting the programme's progression requirements are guaranteed admission to that master's. Progression requirements may vary by programme. All necessary credits will be transferred to students' home universities after completing the programme.
