Minutes of the meeting of Academic Council Wednesday 12 February 2025, 2pm Theatre C007 Health Sciences Centre

The meeting of Academic Council was chaired by the President, Professor Orla Feely.

1 Introduction

Apologies

The Chair acknowledged that a number of apologies had been received and will be noted into the record.

2 Minutes and Matters Arising

Minutes of the meeting held on 23 October 2024

Item 3, Additional Considerations for Assessment Policy – Proposed Amendment

The Chair informed members that a proposed amendment to the minutes had been received from Associate Professor Philip Cottrell; it was requested that the minutes be amended to reflect that the feedback given regarding the proposed Additional Circumstances Policy were not solely from the Head of School, but were expressed on behalf of the entire School of Art History and Cultural Policy.

The minutes were approved subject to the above amendment being made.

Matters Arising

Item 3, Additional Considerations for Assessment Policy – Proposed Amendment

A member queried the current status of, and timelines around, the Additional Considerations Policy. The Registrar confirmed that while the Policy was approved in principle, operational details have not yet been finalised. UCD Assessment is looking at resource capacity requirements alongside IT Services in advance of the establishment of the implementation Working Group.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION / DECISION BY ACADEMIC COUNCIL

3 UCD Strategy 2025-2030 – Implementation of Academic-Related Actions

The President introduced this item highlighting that Academic Council has a role to play in identifying important priority items for implementation and action over the next five years that underpin our strategic initiatives. The Registrar gave a presentation outlining the first set of planned priorities related to academic governance which fall under the initiatives 'Learning for Life', 'Student Experience' and 'Research with Ambition'. The following priorities were discussed:

- Curriculum Review
- Flexible and Part Time Learning
- Scholarships and Prizes Review
- Work Integrated Learning
- Academic Advising

The Registrar advised that consultation with Heads of School is already underway. Schools are being asked to think about what core skills are not currently available within their progammes and to consider other modes that can provide students with structured opportunities to develop their knowledge and skills in areas such as AI and digital skills, innovation, sustainability, leadership, well-being, and languages. The focus is not to change what schools do but to support what schools want to do and build on the existing platform. As we become more flexible we need to adopt and develop tech to support outlying activity. The key goals must be understood in terms of quality and capacity.

Academic Council was informed that aspects of research activity have an academic governance dimension and the Vice President for Research, Innovation and Impact would like an opportunity to raise the visibility of research initiatives with Academic Council at a future meeting. Furthermore, it was agreed that an update on the implementation of academic-related actions under the UCD Strategy should be included as a regular item at AC meetings.

The Chairs of AC Subcommittees were encouraged to bring forward items under development to Academic Council for consideration.

Decision Academic Council welcomed the implementation plan of academic-related actions under the UCD Strategy 2025-2030.
