

## Instruction to students at the start

**You can read the statement in blue below or play the YouTube survey instruction video instead.**

**The YouTube survey instruction video link, survey link, and unique school password will be supplied by email to each school survey coordinator before the mid-term break.**

Each student should have their own separate desk and Support Services Card. It is preferable that the layout of the desks is the same as during exams or at least arranged so that the students cannot easily see each other's screens.

**Don't let the students begin until you have explained the following points to them:**

The Planet Youth survey will be used to help improve young people's services in the region and your answers are important.

**It is confidential and anonymous** and there is no way that your answers can be traced back to you. We would like you to be as honest as possible and consider your answers carefully. There are no right or wrong answers, the important thing is sharing your opinion.

Some of the questions are sensitive and adult in theme. Because of that there are details of local support services on the card you've been provided with. You should keep these cards, or maybe take a photograph of it, just in case the questions bring up anything that you would like help with.

If you are not comfortable answering a question, or do not want to answer a question, just leave it blank. You don't have to answer every question but try your best to do so and try to get to the end.

If you don't understand any question, stick your hand up and we'll come to you with a paper version that we can look at together and explain it. You should cover or close your screen while we do this so you cannot see your answers.

It is important that the atmosphere is quiet and that you do not compare answers.

You have one hour to complete the survey, and everyone is staying until the end, so just relax or do some homework if you finish it early.
