# Anonymisation of data

The dataset was reviewed according to the UKAN standard.

There are no direct identifiers in the dataset. Name, address and telephone number were collected at the time of the survey by Amarach Consulting and stored separately to the main dataset. The identifying data was destroyed by Amarach two months after collection was completed.

The dataset was assessed for indirect identifiers and the wider picture assessed by running descriptive statistics and crosstabs to find unique cases, that is, combinations of variables that could identify an individual. Following assessment, the some variables were redacted from the dataset, as listed in *Variables in the questionnaire*, not in the dataset.

## **Variables**

One variable was altered to preserve anonymity. Q6\_1,which asked respondents how many bedrooms their house had, was topcoded at ten or more bedrooms with the consequence that there is one derived variable in the dataset: Topcoded Q6\_1 number of bedrooms.
