- Assessment components, remediation and feedback strategies are recorded and are accurate
- The Approaches to Teaching & Learning field in the Content/Learning Outcomes section is updated to indicate whether / to what extent AI may be used
- Details of the staff/faculty associated with the module in the Access to Modules section are reviewed in line with GDPR principles, so that only those with current requirement to view student information have this access
- All other mandatory sections of the descriptor are complete and anomalies addressed. The <u>Modules Missing Data</u> report on InfoHub will highlight where action is required
