Policy Updates

Throughout 2021/22, a number of policies under the remit of ACCE were reviewed and updated:

- [UCD Examination Regulations](#) were further amended in 2021/22 to enhance the support of remote examinations following the introduction of COVID-related restrictions

- [The Assessment Code of Practice](#) (ACOP) was updated to include more detailed information on online exams, clinical assessments, and communication to students regarding assessments
- [The Aegrotat and Posthumous Guidelines](#) were amended to better reflect international best practice. The changes provide greater clarity on what aegrotat and posthumous awards are, and provide clear criteria for when they can be applied and how they can be sought
