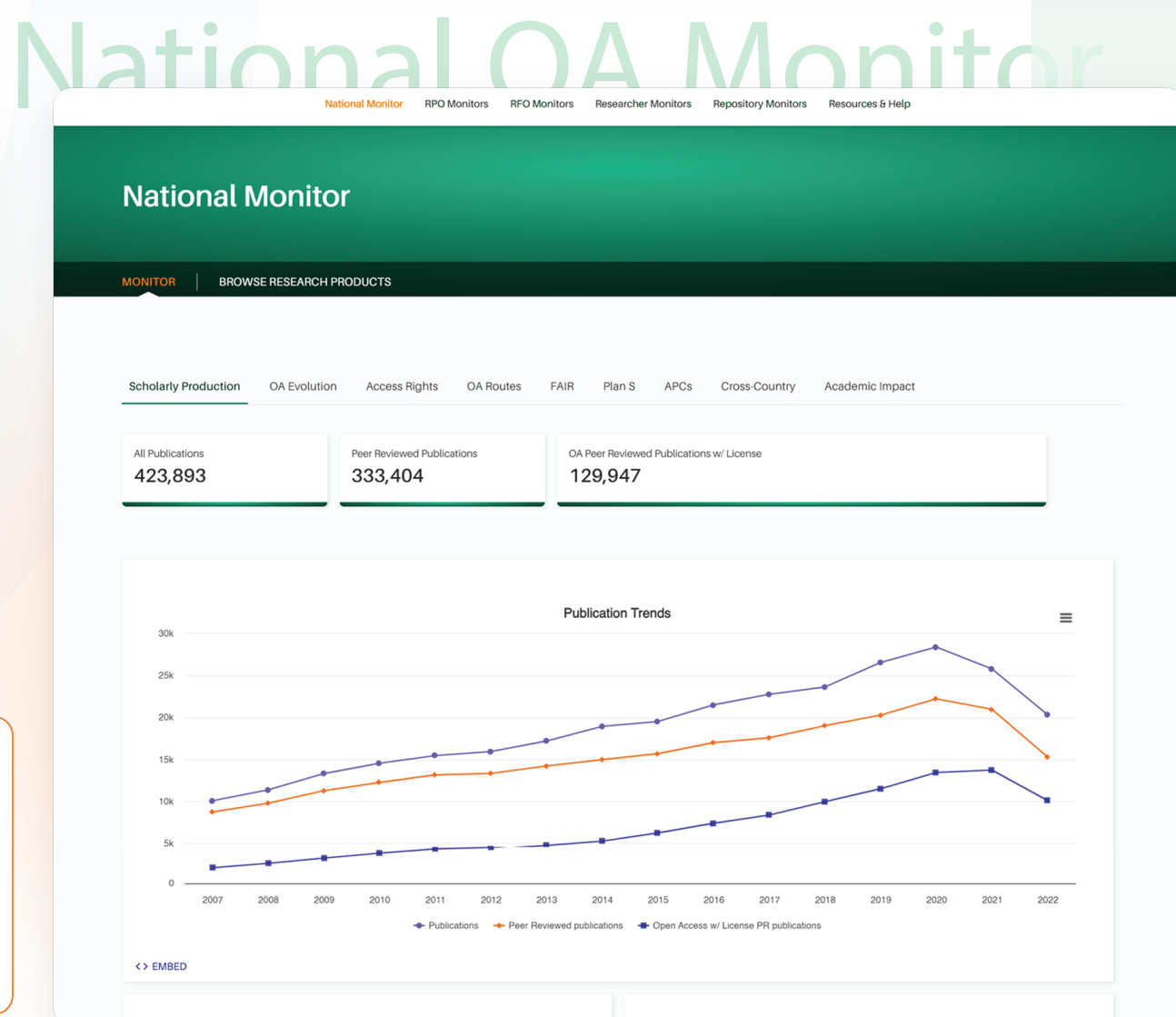

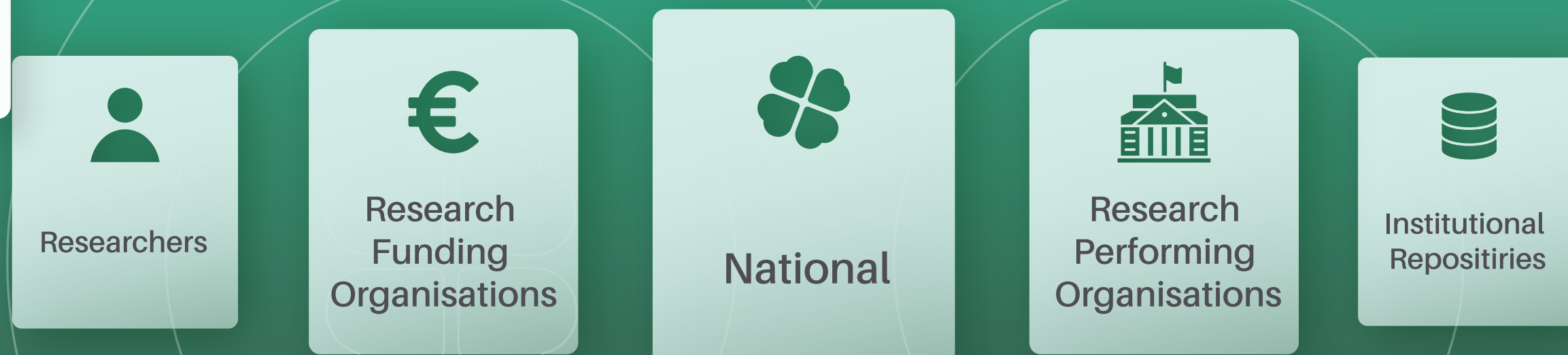

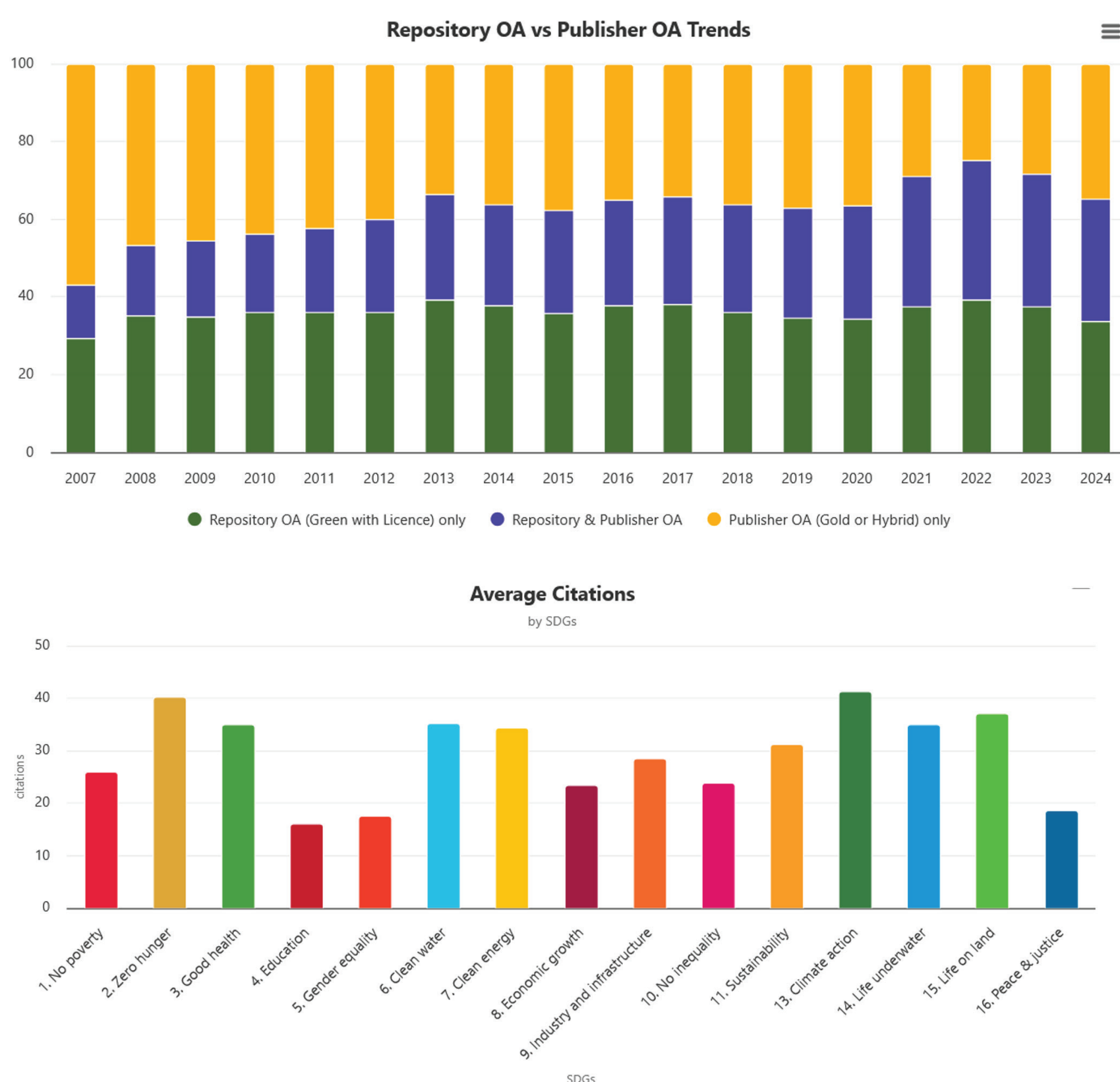
- To provide transparent, comprehensive insights into the state of Open Access in Ireland.

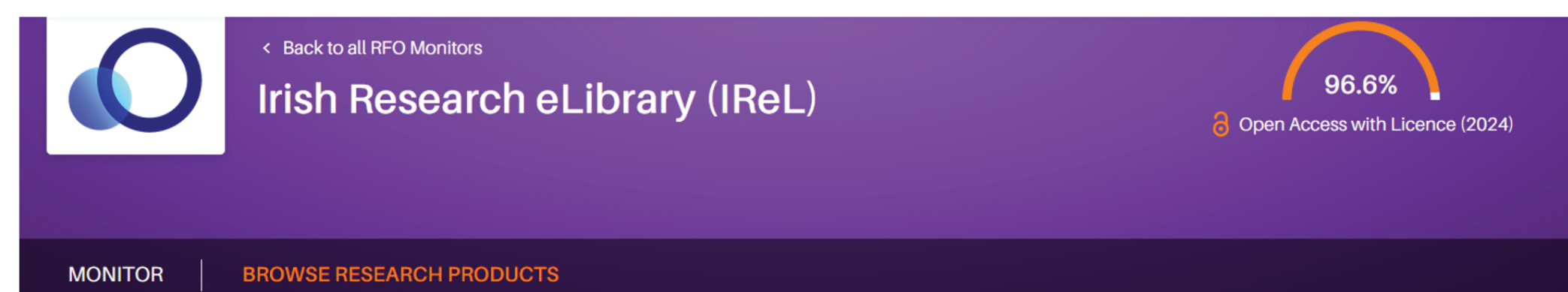
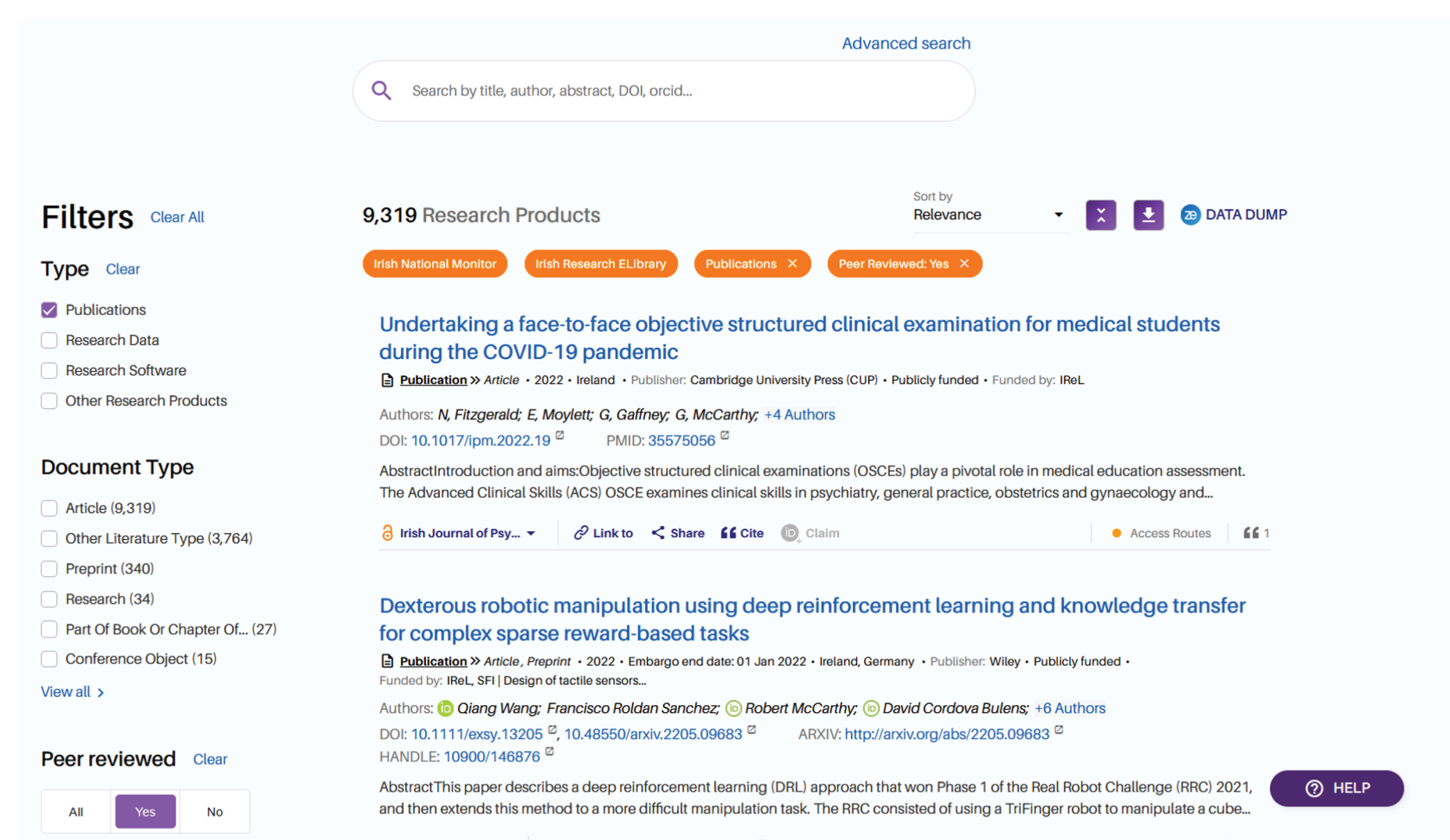
INDICATORS VIEW

- Benchmark nationally and internationally



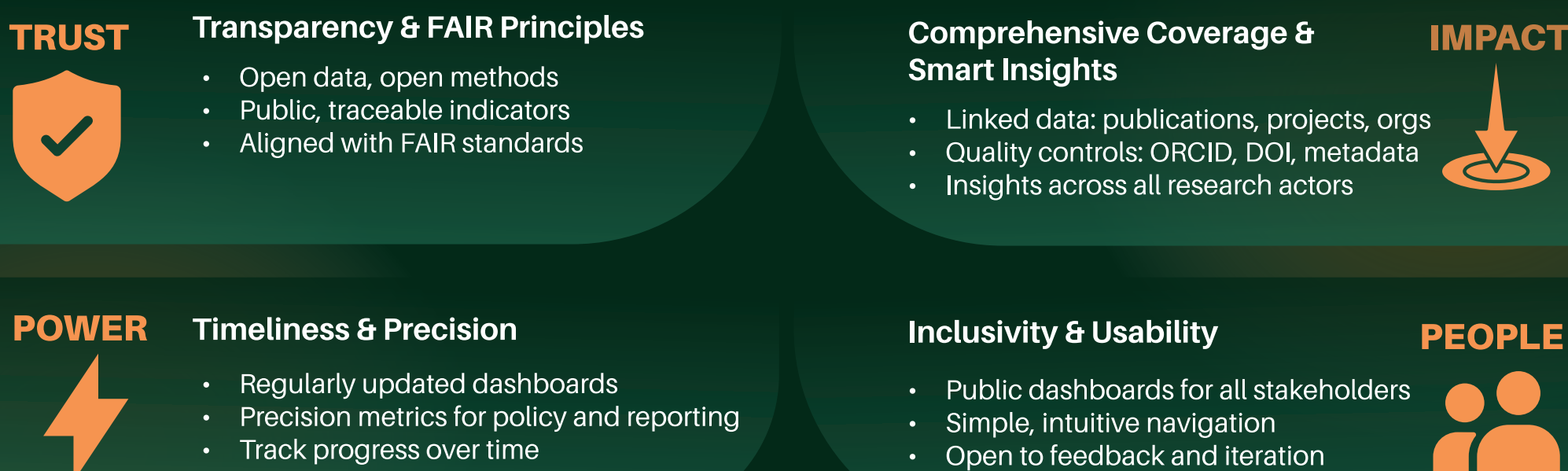
RESEARCH OUTPUTS VIEW

- Drill down by author, repository, or project

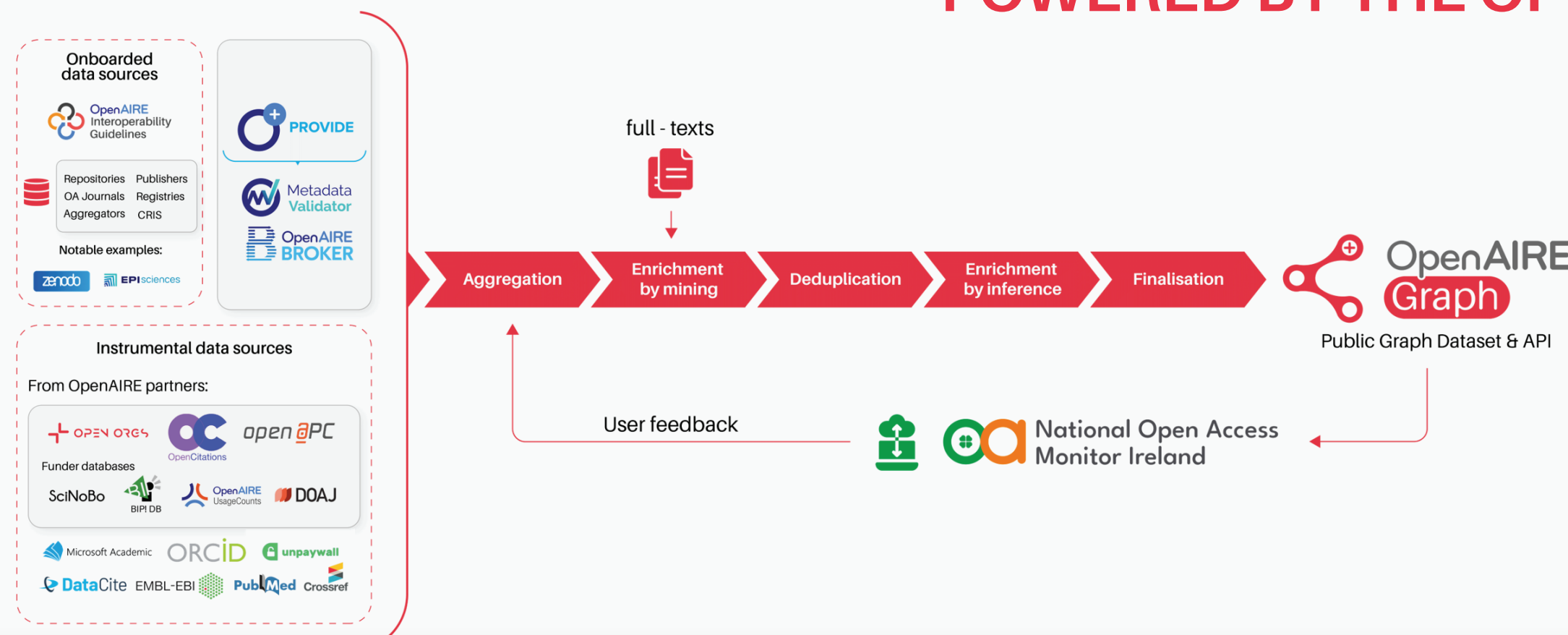


THE FOUR PILLARS OF THE MONITOR
