ABSTRACT

Non-Private Household (NPH) sub-groups – for example those living in nursing homes, hospitals, homeless shelters, emergency accommodation or prisons– are highly dependent on welfare services, receiving considerable amounts of social policy energy, resources and attention. Paradoxically though, we know surprisingly little about their living conditions, transitions and, in turn, how policy design and implementation affect them. This empirical 'blind spot' stems from their consistent exclusion from the core population surveys that underpin research and policymaking. The study integrates and harmonizes survey, administrative, and national account data for the first time to uncover the living conditions and social rights access of NPHs. In doing so, it offers a new lens for evaluating the inclusiveness and equity of social citizenship in Europe.
