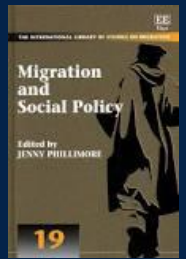

Jenny Phillimore is a world leading scholar in refugee integration, superdiversity and access to social welfare focusing on public health, as well as publishing and development of the community research methodology. Over the past decade she has researched access to health, education, employment, training, and housing integration with a particular focus on integration and organisational change in the UK and EU. She is a Fellow of the RSA and of the Academy of the Social Sciences & advisor to local, regional, national and European Government. Jenny led the ESRC/Norface funded UPWEB project which is developing a new concept of welfare bricolage to explore how residents in superdiverse areas address health concerns. Currently she leads the international SEREDA project on the incidence and nature of sexual and gender-based violence (SGBV) experienced by women, men and child refugees who have fled conflict in the Levant Region.
