Holds Information

If you have a hold on your account, you will find more information under "Active Holds on your Record". This appears on the Registration, Fees and Assessment tab in SISWeb.

Holds on your student record can restrict access to several different things: programme placements, examination results, Transcripts and official documents, registration and conferring, attending programme placements.

Some of the most common holds include: Hardbound Thesis hold, Qualification Check Hold, Fee Hold, Garda Vetting Hold.

All PHD and Masters by Research students must submit a physical, <u>final hardbound</u> thesis to the Student Desk.

If your offer has been made based on scanned documents or copies of documents you will be required to have your qualifications checked. Make sure to check the link for more information on this process.

You must pay your fees by the fee payment deadlines. These are published online.

You will need to be <u>Garda vetted</u> if you are taking one of the programmes or modules which require vetting or you are doing a placement in a setting with children or vulnerable adults.
