Exam Timetable and Dates

There are two Summer exam sessions: Undergraduate exams: 28 July – 1 August Graduate taught exams: 16 – 23 August (Some graduate exams may be scheduled earlier if requested.)

In-person exams will take place at: Blackrock Exam Centre Smurfit Building (*for students with Disability Support arrangements – AEADS*)

Assessments Not on the Timetable

Some assessments during the exam period may not appear on your timetable (e.g. take-home assessment, classroomheld exams). If:

A module you expect to be examined in is not listed, or

You see a timetable clash, and

Your Module Coordinator has not contacted you,

Please contact your School Office immediately.

In-Person Exams

Check the Student Assessment website for directions to the exam venues.

Bring: Writing materials, any required medication, your UCD Student Card (UCARD).

You must bring your UCARD to verify your identity. Failure to do so may delay entry and will be reported to the UCD Student Engagement, Conduct, Complaints and Appeals Office for breach of exam regulations and may incur a fine.

The use of electronic devices (e.g. phones, smartwatches) are strictly prohibited, unless approved in advance through a Needs Assessment by UCD Access & Lifelong Learning.

Check your seat number in SISWeb before the exam. If not available, ask an invigilator or an Exam Helper when you arrive – they're there to help.

Students with approved exam supports should also check their exam details in SISWeb and will receive a confirmation email.

Use the free cloakroom to store bags and personal items - bags are not permitted in the exam hall.

Do not attend an in-person exam if you have symptoms of COVID-19 or another infectious illness. See HSE guidance and information on the Extenuating Circumstances process.
