



UCD Exams - what can I bring to my exam?

So here are the things to bring with you to [the exam centre](#):

- Your UCARD
- Pens and pencils, and an eraser if your exam is an MCQ.
- Depending on the time of year, you may wish to wear layers of warm clothing.
- You can bring water to the Exam. Make sure to remove the labels from the bottle!
- You may also need a calculator, which your Module Coordinator can confirm. If you do, your Module coordinator should inform you before the exam whether the calculator is to be non-programmable or programmable.



Remember:

- Power off your electronic devices
- Leave pencil cases, glasses cases, and wallets under your desk or in a location instructed by an invigilator and don't access them during the exam.
- Leave your bag in a secure safe area outside the exam hall.

All items brought into the Exam Hall are done so at your own risk and may be searched by invigilators.
