The Irish Anzacs Project is a research undertaking of the **Global Irish Studies Centre** at **University of New South Wales**, made possible by a grant from the Irish government's Emigrant Support Program. The director of the project is Dr Jeff Kildea, **Keith Cameron Chair of Australian History** at **University College Dublin**. The event at UCD will occur simultaneously via video link with a launch event at UNSW.

The Irish Anzacs Project aims to identify all Irish-born enlistments in the Australian Imperial Force (AIF) during the First World War and to compile a publicly accessible database containing information on each of them. The database will provide families with information on their Irish-born family members who served in the AIF during the war as well as statistical information to assist researchers to understand better the contribution of the Irish to the Australian war effort.
